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Wehrer called meeting to order. Roll call taken, Wehrer, Sudbeck, Riedel, Schwede, and Lutz in attendance. Wehrer informed public as to current copy and public accessibility of Open Meetings Act. Motion made by Riedel to accept March minutes, second by Sudbeck. All in favor. Motion carried. Motion made by Lutz to accept official treasurer report, second by Sudbeck. All in favor. Motion carried. Steven Jessen was present to discuss the Hadar Ridge Estate Assessment. Motion made by Lutz to continue to remove snow until remainder of the spring until the Subdivision Agreement can be amended, second by Riedel. All in favor. Motion carried. A Special Meeting for amending said Agreement and to discuss HRE annexing with the Village of Hadar will be set at the May regular village meeting. George Thietje presented the board with a quote for insurance through LARM with a yearly contract. Rick Sirek from Town & Country Insurance presented to the board a dividend check for \$1,107.12 from EMC Insurance. Sirek also introduced the board to Riley Tonkin from EMC Insurance. Tonkin presented a packet of EMC's corporate review for 2012. Discussed the cost and advantages of hanging a defibrillator in the Community Building. Motion made by Riedel to accept the donated defibrillator by Lutz and the donated costs of \$434.30 for supplies and a cabinet by Town and Country, second by Sudbeck. All in favor. Motion carried. Discussed a walking path along Old Hadar Road that was estimated at costing about \$28,000.00. Lower Elkhorn National Resources District may help with half the cost via a grant. The board will be looking into other option at a lower cost. Discussed banner hardware and new banners for the Village of Hadar. Schwede will be burning items in the Dump on April 15<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 pm. A Special Meeting will be set for April 23<sup>rd</sup> at 7:00pm at the Community Building, 202 S 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave., Hadar, NE, to get written requests and information for the Community Web-site. Discussed the 2013 NE Municipal Clerk Institute that I attended. Motion made by Lutz to pay membership dues of \$10.00 for NE Municipal Clerks' Association, second by Sudbeck. All in favor. Motion carried. Discussed the expenses involved in attending the Institute. Motion made by Lutz to accept the expenses for attending the Institute including hourly pay of \$10.00 and mileage, second by Sudbeck. All in favor. Motion carried. Discussed department updates for streets, parks, sewer, and animal control. Discussed the fact that some doors may need to be replaced on some of the Village of Hadar Buildings. Gary Schuett stated that the generator will need to be serviced.
